Museum definition:

Dhofar Museum is an important icon to highlight the Omani identity. It is educational and non-profit, and aims primarily to introduce the historical perspective of human cultural heritage and build a unique broad base for our contemporary thought. It also seeks to document all aspects of heritage in an integrated cultural project that describes the life aspects of our ancient heritage, as it is



known and famous for the style of the ancient past in its wonderful contents and features, as it includes several environments, each of which displays a part through which the history of the region is shown, such as Islamic culture, culture, terms, images, and the embodiment of the features of the ancient past of Dhofar and the Sultanate of Oman and civilizations, including Samharam, Al Baleed, and Wabar, and their important role in the cultural, civilizational, and commercial returns, and the historical navigational role of the Omani Empire and other cultures, history, and Arab kingdoms. The visitor can also enjoy exploring these exhibits by passing through the museum corridors using modern technology for the introductory material and valuable collectibles that tell stories and memories along the interconnected kinetic path. Dhofar Museum symbolizes the antiquity of Dhofari heritage, where its location was chosen in the middle of the old region (Central Salalah) where cultures and customs are rooted, as it is the strategic residence that lies between the dimensions of farms, the beach, the plain, the countryside and the desert. It is considered one of the largest private museums in Dhofar Governorate and displays modern rock art to copies of identical ancient buildings. It is also considered one of the most entertaining museums to explore many of the collections that simulate a story and a memory that is rooted in the visitor's mind.

To consolidate and embody the noble Omani values by focusing on highlighting the cultural treasure and highlighting the Omani identity and the guaranteed history.

Establishment of the Museum:

Dhofar Museum was established in 2013 AD in the courtyard of the house of its owner, Sheikh/ Mohammed bin Abdul Mohsen Salem Al-Sail Al-Ghassani, as he was interested in collecting collectibles since the fifties until the idea developed into highlighting this inventory for an integrated museum by allocating a building for it in 2015 in compliance with the enlightening words of His Majesty the late Sultan/ Qaboos bin Said, may God bless his soul: (He who has no past has no



present) and in line with the interest of His Majesty Sultan/ Haitham bin Tariq, may God protect him and preserve him, regarding preserving the Omani identity; where work was done on this desired dream with personal efforts and facing challenges; the efforts were crowned by the solidarity of many sons, individuals, experts and volunteers and the cooperation of the Ministry of Heritage and Tourism to see the light with its opening in 2024/2025.

Dhofar Museum Logo:

The Dhofar Museum logo symbolizes (Legacy and Trace), as (Legacy) is the Omani architectural style and its civilization as a base rooted in gold color bearing the details of the handicraft in the palm frond industry that distinguishes Dhofar. The gradation of colors also suggests the connection between the legacy and its authenticity as a legacy to highlight the Omani identity, and (the trace) is intended as a thumbprint and an addition suggested by the shape of the logo and symbolizes the documentation of all the features of the Omani heritage.



Museum building:

The Dhofari heritage style was designed on the building, as the exterior of the building indicates authenticity by simulating the old traditional style of the region among the old buildings. It was designed from the inside with antique wood for the floors and old ceilings made from local materials. The Dhofar Museum building consists of a basement, a ground floor, and shops outside where visitors can buy souvenirs and enjoy the experience of Omani coffee and some foods.

Sultan Qaboos Mosque and Dhofar Club are nearby landmarks, in addition to the museum being located next to the Big House (Beit Al-Sail Heritage House) and the Dar Al-Kutub Public Library, as Dhofar Museum is about 450 meters away from Sultan Qaboos Mosque and only about 100 meters away from Dhofar Club, as Dhofar Museum is located in the heart of the old central Salalah area near Al-Salam Street and you can use the turn at the exit opposite the bus and taxi station on Al-Salam Street

Founder of Dhofar Museum:

Sheikh/ Mohammed Abdul Mohsen Salem Al Sail Al Ghassani

General features of his career:

- Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdul Mohsen bin Salem Al Sail Al Ghassani is a person with multiple interests, as he combined government, private and voluntary work, and contributed to supporting the sports movement by establishing the first bodybuilding gym in the Sultanate, in addition to his activity in establishing and managing sports clubs.
- He contributed to the development of the economic and commercial sector through his management of Al Ghassani Trading and Contracting Establishment and the Oman Chamber of Commerce and Industry, as well as being one of the founding partners in the Global Quarries Group of Companies.
- His community giving extended through his active participation in the Dhofar Municipality Committees and Tourism Development Committees and his contribution to charitable and educational work, as he chaired the Parents Council in a number of schools in Dhofar Governorate, with the aim of raising the level of education and supporting students.

Dhofar Private Museum:

• He concluded his career full of giving and established Sheikh Mohammed Al-Ghassani Dhofar Private Museum (2024-2025), which represents a platform for preserving local heritage and Omani history, and plays an awareness and cultural role to serve the community, confirming his keenness to keep the Omani heritage vibrant and transmitted to future generations
